- d. The Committee for Conduction of Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activity shall meet at least once in every quarter to identify areas of improvement.
- The Secretary or the In-charge of the event will be the Nodal officer.
- The Nodal officer of the committee will schedule a meeting in consultation with the honorable Chairman of the committee and accordingly inform all other members well in advance.
- g. The Nodal officer of the committee will be responsible to maintain all the records, documents such as directions, Circulars, notifications and GR of different authorities related to functions of respective committee and minutes of the meetings and will summit data as and when required.

- 1. The Committee shall be responsible for all intra and inter collegiate events in the College along with Celebrations of National Days.
- 2. The Committee shall provide necessary infrastructure for all events and Physical educational
- 3. Plan tentative dates to be included in the academic calendar of the institute.
- 4. Create zeal amongst students, staffs & faculty members towards various events.
- 5. The committee shall serve for planning, guiding and monitoring activities of the Institute related to

- a. Physical educational facility
- b. Recreational facility;
- c. Activities related to national service scheme and the like;
- d. Formation of various student clubs such as adventures club, science club, environment club, sanskrit club, photography club, animal lovers club and the like;
- e. Community outreach programme, cultural events and the like;
- f. Medical camps or village adoption or health awareness programme and the like;
- g. Field visits or survey and the like;
- h. Conducting seminar, workshop, brain storming sessions, symposium and the like
- 6. Organize training, coaching and education in sports and other events for everybody so that they can learn to keep themselves physically fit.
- 7. Prepare budget for all events and take necessary steps for its approval.
- 8. Monitoring proper maintenance of sports and other accessories necessary for conduction of Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activity
- 9. Maintain record of all activities attended by students within the college, university and outside of the region/state.
- 10. Prepare the details of attendance exemption to be given to the students representing college in various events
- 11. The Committee shall analyses the Provision and utilization of students' amenities (Indoor & outdoor sport facilities, extra-curricular activities etc.)
