Research Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Cell INSTITUTIONAL INNOVATION COMMITTEE (IIC)

The Institutional Innovation Committee shall consist of the following persons, namely: -

Head of the Institute- Chairperson;

- Senior faculty member known for visionary and creative activity- co-ordinator;
- Three faculty members (one from each profession) Member; and
- Two students (one boy and one girl) from each batch Member.

A faculty member of the college familiar with research, publication and Intellectual Property Rights or who has undergone training conducted by the Commission or as specified by the Commission from time to time or after appointment of coordinator he or she shall undergo the training within six months.

S.O.P.

- 1- The Institutional Innovation Committee shall meet at least once in every quarter to identify areas of improvement.
- 2- The coordinator of the committee will schedule a meeting in consultation with the honorable Chairman of the committee and accordingly inform all other members well in advance.
- 3- The coordinator of the committee will be responsible to maintain all the records, documents such as directions, Circulars, notifications and GR of different authorities related to functions of respective committee and minutes of the meetings and will summit data as and when required.

Functions of Institutional Innovation Committee (IIC)

- 1- The committee shall plan, execute and monitor the activities of Research Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Cell which facilitate activities related to innovation, incubation, research, publication and intellectual property rights.
- 2- Institutional Innovation Committee (IIC) should keep co-ordination with Institutional Research Committee (IRC), Institutional Ethics committee (IEC) for human subjects and Institutional Animal Ethics Committee. All these functions under department of Integrative Health and Translational Research.
- 3- The Institutional Innovation Committee shall identify or invite the innovative ideas from the students (For CCRAS-SPARK, CCRAS-PG STAR etc schemes), teachers and other staff of the Institute and facilitate to incubate or nurture the ideas and to translate to useful products or outcome. Innovations may be in teaching, diagnostics, therapeutic equipment, surgical equipment, dosage forms, drug delivery systems, software, applications, assessment scales and the like.
- 4- Institutional policy shall develop to support activities related to innovation, incubation, research, publication, Intellectual Property Rights, disbursement of research grants, research incentives, publication incentives and the like.
- 5- The policy shall be oriented to all stake holders and developed implementation and monitoring mechanism.
- 6- Institutional Innovation Committee shall analyses the Research Output & Impact Framework
 - a. Total number of research paper publications by Faculty Staff with Institutional Affiliation in indexed Journals as Principal/First Author/Second Author

- b. Cumulative Citation Scores of research papers published in indexed journals
- No. of patents/copy rights filed by the Institution
- d. No. of patents/ copy rights granted
- e. No. of Collaboration projects completed / ongoing in collaboration with Industry / Non-government (National, State/International) funding agency
- f. No. of projects completed/ongoing funded being lunded by government agency in India and abroad like RAV New Delhi, Ministry of AYUSH CSIR. ICMR. CCRAS. DST, CCRAS Regional Institute, CCRAS National Institute, DST, etc.
- Total Seed money allocated for promotion of Research Activities
